The polar bear lives on the ice and 'snow / rocks of the polar regions. Everywhere is white, so its white fur blends in with its surroundings. Polar bears can run 'fast / slowly, and they can swim, too.

- Stonefish live in the ocean. They like to eat fish, so they sit on the bottom of the ocean / tree and wait. They look like stones, so the fish can't see them. If a fish touches it, the stonefish stings it and kills it. Then it eats the fish.
